Dave's Guide to catching up on Star Trek*

Took me a while but, as promised, here's my guide to the best of *Star Trek*. This is, in my opinion the best order in which to watch them, and the episodes from each series that will give you a good idea of what *Star Trek* is all about. Hopefully, you'll be interested enough to watch everything eventually—but this will give you a good start.

One thing you'll discover if you watch in this order is that, because of the way they were originally broadcast, Next Generation overlaps with Deep Space Nine, and Deep Space Nine overlaps with Voyager. Luckily, there's not too much crossover, so you should be fine. ©

Star Trek (Original Series)

Most people would start new viewers on *Star Trek: The Next Generation*—and that's actually not a *bad* place to start. Feel free to skip these if you want. But I think this handful of episodes provides a good taste of what the original series was about and gives you some "historical" background. (This series takes place about 80 years before *Next Generation*.)

Season 1:

- 1. Where No Man Has Gone Before—the second pilot for the series
- The Menagerie Part 1 and 2—the first pilot for the series folded into a two-part episode
- 3. Balance of Terror—introduces an ongoing enemy, the Romulans
- **4. The Galileo Seven**—mainly included because this is the first episode of *Star Trek* I ever saw ©
- **5. Errand of Mercy**—introduces an ongoing enemy and eventual ally, the Klingons
- 6. Space Seed—the best of the movies is a sequel to this episode
- 7. City on the Edge of Forever—widely considered the best episode of the Original Series

Season 2:

- **8. Amok Time**—great Spock episode; lots of background on the Vulcans
- **9.** *Mirror*, *Mirror*—introduces an alternate universe that shows up in other series
- **10.The Doomsday Machine—**MY favorite episode of the Original Series **11.** *I, Mudd*

^{*} Without watching 800+ episodes and 13 movies.

- 12. Metamorphosis
- **13. Journey to Babel**—another good Spock episode
- **14. Obsession**—No particular reason other than that it's a good episode
- **15.The Trouble with Tribbles**—great comedy episode that's referenced in other series occasionally
- **16.** A Piece of the Action—another funny episode
- 17. The Immunity Syndrome—just another good one
- **18.The Ultimate Computer**—ditto

Season 3:

- **19.The Enterprise Incident**—another Romulan episode

Bonus points if you watch:

- **22.Spock's Brain**—one of the top 5 worst episodes ever of any series
- 23. Spectre of the Gun—one that I think is okay but is really weird
- **24.** The Way to Eden—as far I can tell, I am the ONLY Star Trek fan who likes this one (the songs are great)

Original Series Movies:

- Star Trek II: The Wrath of Khan—sequel to the episode Space Seed, and best of the movies
- **Star Trek III**: **The Search for Spock**—not the greatest film...but it continues the story of *Wrath of Khan*
- **Star Trek IV: The Voyage Home**—just a fun, lighter movie to wrap up the II, III, IV trilogy
- Star Trek VI: The Undiscovered Country—almost as good as Wrath of Khan

Star Trek: The Animated Series

This was a 1972 cartoon series that had only 22 episodes. It was a continuation of The Original Series. You aren't missing much by skipping it entirely. ©

Star Trek: The Next Generation

Honestly, this is where most people new to the series start. It's a lot more...modern...than the Original Series, and is the template for all of the newer *Trek* series.
